KENNEL UNION OF SOUTHERN AFRICA REGULATIONS FOR FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOWS

SCHEDULE 03A

(Effective 01.03.2025)

1. The Executive Committee shall have authority, delegated by the Federal Council, to issue Licences in accordance with the Regulations relating thereto. The FCI grants permission for its Members to hold FCI Shows.
2. An FCI Show is a Show at which the relevant FCI Regulations generally apply. Dogs are judged according to FCI Breed Standards for all FCI recognised Breeds where any FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® (Certificate d'Aptitude au Championnat International) and/ or FCI-C.A.C.I.A.G.® (Certificate d'Aptitude au Championnat International d'Agility) and/ or FCI-C.A.C.I.T.® (Certificate d' Aptitude au Championnat International de Travail de la FCI) awards are on offer. Such Show may be held by the Kennel Union or by an All-breeds Club granted a Licence by the Executive Committee to hold such Show in addition to their Annual Championship Show(s).
 - 2.1 The Kennel Union shall hold one (1) FCI Show in each calendar year.
 - 2.2 Any All-breeds Club may apply to hold one (1) FCI Show in each calendar year.
 - 2.3 Every application for a Licence to hold an FCI Show shall be made not less than one year before the proposed date on an official Kennel Union form, signed on behalf of the applicant Club, by the Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary setting out the information required therein.
3. All matters relating to licensing and all other matters to do with Shows as set out in the Schedules of the Constitution of the Kennel Union shall apply to the FCI Show insofar as they can be relevant and do not conflict with the specific terms of this Schedule 03A.
 - 3.1 Clubs holding FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® International Shows must specify on their Show Schedules whether, or not, Reports (Critiques) would be on offer at the Show and, if so, under which conditions and to which exhibits. (In this regard, refer to the BREED ASSIGNMENT section of the Regulations for FCI Dog Shows)
4. Dogs with cropped ears shall not be eligible for exhibition at an FCI Show, irrespective of any of them being registered by the Kennel Union in terms of Schedule 2 Regulation 7.2.
5. Where FCI Regulations are not covered, then Schedule 3 shall take effect.
6. **Asia, Africa and Oceania (A20) Section of the FCI**

KUSA became a member of the above Section of the FCI with effect from the date of the FCI's General Assembly in Shanghai, China, i.e. on 20 April 2019.

From that date, KUSA became eligible to avail itself of the following concessions permitted to the A20 Section by the FCI.

 - 6.1 **FCI International Champion Title FCI-C.I.B.®**
 - 4 FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® (no matter the number of countries)
 - FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® to be awarded by four (4) different Judges from three (3) different countries
 - No Working Tests or Working Trials for dogs from Groups 1 to 8
 - No period of one (1) year and one (1) day between awards
 - 6.2 **Optional Seven Groupings at International (FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®) Shows**

The following *combinations* apply:

 - Groups 7 & 8
 - Groups 4, 6 & 10
 - 6.3 **FCI International Junior & Veteran Beauty Champion Titles FCI-C.I.B.-J® & FCI-C.I.B.-V®**
 - Three (3) FCI International Junior or Veteran Certificates (i.e. three (3) "1st Excellent" in Junior or Veteran Class) awarded in one or more countries as from 1 August 2022
 - In each of the instances above, "Junior" or "Veteran" awards must be made by three (3) different Judges originating from three (3) different countries

- Applicable to all breeds (whether subject to a Working Test, or not) registered on the Primary Breed Register
- All Applications for FCI-C.I.B.-J® and FCI-C.I.B.-V® Titles must be submitted to KUSA on the Application Form provided
- KUSA will make application to the FCI on behalf of the Applicant.

Extract from FCI Breed Show Regulations (for information only):

In shows held under Licence of the FCI the following classes are compulsory:

1. Classes in which a FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® may be awarded:
 - Intermediate Class - from 15 up to 24 months
 - Open Class - from 15 months upwards
 - Working Class - from 15 months with FCI Working Dog Certificate
 - Champion Class - from 15 months KUSA/FCI Champion
2. Classes in which a Best of Breed may be awarded:
 - Junior Class - from 9 to under 18 months
 - Veteran Class - from 8 years and over

* Brace/Couple Class/Competition	A dog and a bitch of the same breed and variety and belonging to the same owner. Each exhibit having been entered in a compulsory breed class.
* Progeny Class / Competition	Sire & Dam with minimum three (3) and maximum five (5) of his/her progeny (first generation, sons/daughters) Each exhibit having been entered in a compulsory breed class.

* These classes are Optional. All the rest are compulsory.

DECLARATION BY THE REGISTERED OWNER / AUTHORISED AGENT

By attaching my signature to this form, or where the form is submitted electronically, by inserting my full name and surname I, the Registered Owner of, or I, the Authorised Agent for, the dog hereby entered for exhibition, affirm that I have read and understood the full contents of this Entry Form and hereby declare that:

- I am aware that only Members of the Kennel Union are entitled to enter and have dogs in their registered ownership compete in any Championship Dog Show, Championship Obedience Class, Championship Working Trial, or any other Championship event licensed by the Kennel Union, save for Breed Classes offered at Specialist Club Championship Shows where entries will also be open to non-members, and am in full compliance with this requirement at the time of entry and shall remain in full compliance up to and including the time of exhibition of the dog hereby entered.
- The dog hereby entered is eligible to be exhibited at a KUSA-licensed Dog Show and its Registration Certificate is free from any endorsement restricting such exhibition.
- By entering, exhibiting or handling a dog at any Show held under a Kennel Union licence, or by permitting a dog in my registered ownership to be so exhibited or handled by another person who is not a member in good standing of KUSA, I agree to be bound by the KUSA Constitution in its entirety, including all the Schedules thereto ("the Constitution").
- I am aware that it is against the Constitution for a dog that has either suffered from, or been exposed to, any infectious or contagious disease(s) within six (6) weeks prior to the Show, or that is suffering from such disease(s) at the time of the Show, to attend a Show and that the contravention of this Regulation might render me liable for disciplinary action under Schedule 1 Rule 4.
- That the dog hereby entered for exhibition is entered to be exhibited entirely at my own risk. Accordingly, unless specifically authorised to be off-lead by a Judge while in the ring carrying out a licensed activity as part of the competition, or while engaged in a practice session prior to participating in the Show, I shall ensure that the dog hereby entered is at all times properly confined, either in an animal crate of suitable size, or on a lead/leash, either hand-held, or securely anchored.
- I acknowledge that a dog is capable of causing damage, injury or harm to other dogs, persons or property at the Show and I accept full responsibility for the safety and behaviour of the dog hereby entered for the duration of the Show, to the extent that I accept personal liability in respect of any claim made in respect of any damage or injury caused by the dog and/or my failure to adequately prevent such catastrophe.
- I indemnify KUSA, its Officials and Officers, the KUSA-affiliated show-holding Club and its Officers, and any employee(s) of the Club, against any and all claims of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising that may be levelled against them, jointly or severally, in respect of any damage or injury or harm caused by the dog hereby entered and/or any failure on my part to adequately control the dog, or arising out of any act, omission, conduct or utterance by me, my appointed agent(s), handler(s), representative(s) or employee(s).
- I am fully responsible and liable for any damage, injury, or harm caused to any person, animal or property arising out of any action by a minor child for whom I am legally responsible and who may be accompanying me, or handling the dog hereby entered, such legal responsibility to continue for the duration of the Show and thereafter during the continued presence of the child on the grounds or in the buildings or amenities where the Show is held. I indemnify and hold harmless KUSA, its Officials and Officers, the KUSA-affiliated show-holding Club, and the Officers and employees of the Club, against any and all claims of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising that may be levelled against them, jointly or severally, in respect of any damage, harm or injury caused by any minor child for whom I am legally responsible at the Show.
- I am fully responsible and liable for any damage, injury, or harm caused to any person, animal or property arising out of any action of a person attending the Show as my employee, assistant or guest and who may, or may not, handle the dog hereby entered, such legal responsibility to continue for the duration of the Show and thereafter during the continued presence of the person on the grounds or in the buildings or amenities where the Show is held. I indemnify and hold harmless KUSA, its Officials and Officers, the KUSA-affiliated show-holding Club, and the Officers and employees of the Club, against any and all claims of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising that may be levelled against them, jointly or severally, in respect of any damage, harm or injury caused by any person attending the show as my employee, guest, assistant or handler of my dogs entered at the Show. I further understand and accept that disciplinary action may be lodged against me in this regard as provided for in terms of Schedule 1 Rule 2.3.2.
- My appointed agent(s), handler(s), representative(s), employee(s), guest(s), assistant(s), any minor children for whom I am legally responsible, and the dog hereby entered for exhibition, shall enter the Show premises, buildings and amenities entirely at my/their own risk and I hereby indemnify and hold harmless KUSA, its Officials, Officers, Members, employees and agents, from and against any and all claims, damages, injury, death, liabilities, judgements, awards, costs, losses and expenses (including all forms of legal fees) caused by, or resulting from, any of the aforesaid at the Show.
- I am familiar with Schedule 3 Regulation 44 with regard to the cancellation or postponement of Shows and the refund or retention (fully or partially) of Show Entry Fees and unreservedly accept and agree to it.
- This Entry Form and the information recorded on it is complete, accurate and true and the document is entirely free of misstatement or any false declaration.
- Should any information on this Entry Form be found to be inaccurate or fraudulent to any degree whatsoever, I am aware that I may be liable for disciplinary action in terms of Schedule 1 Rule 4, resulting in any awards and/or prizes won by the dog hereby entered being withdrawn and/or cancelled.

APPENDIX 1
DEFINITION OF BREED CLASSES AND ORDER OF BREED JUDGING

DEFINITION OF BREED CLASSES

It is **compulsory** for every Championship Show-holding Club holding Breed Classes at an FCI International Championship Show to include the following Classes in the Show Schedule:

MINOR PUPPY (MP):	For dogs of four (4) and under six (6) months of age on the first day of the Show. (Does not compete for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®) (Competes for Best Minor Puppy only.)
PUPPY (PU):	For dogs of six (6) and under nine (9) months of age on the first day of the Show. (Does not compete for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®) (Competes for Best Puppy only.)
JUNIOR (JU):	For dogs of nine (9) and under eighteen (18) months of age on the first day of the Show. (Does not compete for Best Puppy or for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®) (Competes for Best of Breed, but only if the dog has been awarded the Junior FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®. Note: The Judge is not obliged to award the Junior FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®)
INTERMEDIATE (IN):	For dogs of fifteen (15) and under twenty-four (24) months of age on the first day of the Show. (Competes for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®)
OPEN (OP):	For dogs of any Breed therein provided for, but must be fifteen (15) months of age on the first day of the show. (Competes for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®)
WORKING (WO)	Working Breeds of fifteen (15) months of age on the day of the Show with Minimum qualifications: Class "A" Obedience, CD, FCI-IGP 1, or Breed Working Test with at least 75% possible mark. (Competes for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®)
CHAMPION (CH):	For dogs that are a recognised KUSA Champion or FCI International Champion. (Competes for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®)
VETERAN (VE):	For dogs over eight (8) years of age on the first day of the show. (Does not compete for FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®) (Competes for Best of Breed, but only if the dog has been awarded the Veteran FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®. Note: The Judge is not obliged to award the Veteran FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®).

Optional Classes/Competitions:

BREEDERS CLASS/COMPETITION:

Consisting of a minimum of three (3) and maximum of five (5) exhibits of the same breed and variety, without distinction of sex, bred by the same person (same Kennel Name), even if they are not his/her property, each exhibit having been entered in a **compulsory Breed Class**.

BRACE/COUPLE CLASS/COMPETITION:

A dog and a bitch of the same breed and variety and belonging to the same owner, each exhibit having been entered in a **compulsory Breed Class**.

PROGENY CLASS/COMPETITION:

Sire & Dam with minimum three (3) and maximum five (5) of his/her progeny (first generation, sons/daughters), each exhibit having been entered in a **compulsory Breed Class**.

For the purpose of this Appendix, the term "Exhibitor" means the person who has, in terms of the Constitution, entered the dog for the competition.

A Restricted Class is a class for which the entry is restricted to dogs which have accumulated sufficient Challenge Certificate points towards the title of Breed Champion and such title has been awarded by the Kennel Union, or to dogs which have accumulated sufficient FCI-C.A.C.I.B.® points towards the title of International Breed Champion (FCI-C.I.B.®) and such title has been awarded by the FCI.

ORDER OF BREED JUDGING AT FCI INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS

1. Breeds shall, by default, be judged in the order as listed in Schedule 02 Appendix "A2". In the case of:
 - 1.1 A full Group allocated to a single Judge, the breeds will be judged in the order they are listed in Schedule 02 Appendix "A2", unless varied by the Club with good cause and the revised judging order is published in the Official accepted Show Schedule;
 - 1.2 an alphabetically split part Group, e.g. A – M and N – Z, allocated to two different Judges, the breeds will be judged in the split order they are listed in Schedule 02 Appendix "A2", unless varied by the Club with good cause and the revised judging order is published in the Official accepted Show Schedule;
 - 1.3 a randomly split part Group, whether based on numerical strength, size, function or propensity, allocated to two or more different Judges, the order of judging shall be as published in the Show Schedule; and
 - 1.4 randomly selected breeds, allocated to a Judge in addition to a full or part Group, the order of judging shall be as published in the Show Schedule, e.g. [Breed(s) Name(s)] after/before the [Group Name] Group.
2. At FCI International Championship Shows, all breeds shall be judged in accordance with their FCI Breed Standards and, in breeds where more than one variety of the breed is eligible for the awards of FCI-C.A.C.® or FCI-C.A.C.I.B.®, this eligibility shall be strictly observed and applied.
3. In any Group where certain breeds include two or more varieties, the order of judging of those varieties shall be as follows:
