SCHEDULE 5E (13)

REGULATIONS FOR THE KENNEL ASSOCIATION ALL BREEDS SUPREME PUPPY OF THE YEAR COMPETITION (1989)

(Effective 01.04.16)

1. LICENSING AND SHOW REGULATIONS

The Regulations relating to licensing and all other matters to do with Shows as set out in Schedule 3 Regulations for Championship Shows and Schedule 4 Regulations for Non-Championship Shows of the Constitution of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa shall apply to this Competition so far as they can be relevant to the Supreme Puppy of the Year Competition and as far as they do not conflict with the specific terms of this Schedule 5E(13).

2. SCOPE OF THE LICENCE

A Club which is qualified to hold a Championship Show in the calendar year in which it is intended to hold the Supreme Puppy of the Year Competition, may hold the event named in this Schedule in conjunction with such Championship Show or separate therefrom.

3. ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS FOR COMPETITION

Any dog may compete which is registered with the Kennel Union of Southern Africa in the Breed Register, and whose eligibility is not in conflict with the Regulations hereunder described or has not been disqualified or suspended from competition by the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.

4. HOST CLUB

Until or unless this Schedule 5E(13) is amended or altered, the Host Club for the event described in this Schedule 5E(13) will be :

5. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY

5.1 This Competition is open to dogs and bitches and where hereinafter the word dog is used, it may be taken to include bitches.

All winners of the Best Puppy in Show at any All Breeds Championship Show held under a Kennel Union licence in the calendar year previous to that in which it is intended to hold this event may qualify for entry for this event.

6. CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

6.1.1 Special entry forms for Clubs as approved by the Kennel Union of Southern Africa will be supplied to Secretaries of the Show Holding Clubs.

6.1.2 These entry forms, completed, must be returned to the Sponsor within SEVEN (7) days of the Competition of the relevant Championship Show.

6.2.1 Entry forms, as contained in the Show Schedule published by the Sponsor, shall be completed by exhibitors, duly countersigned by the Honorary Secretary of the Show Holding Club, and returned to the Sponsor, as directed on the Show Schedule, by the date given on such Show Schedule.

6.2.2 Entries postmarked on or prior to the closing date will be accepted provided they are received within five (5) days after closing date.

6.3 As this is a prestige event, all competitors will dress in a manner befitting the occasion and will be supplied with numbered bibs or entry numbers by the Sponsor and these will be required to be worn and returned at the conclusion of the event, to the Secretary of the Show Holding Club who, in turn, will return the bibs/entry numbers to the Sponsor (when the event is sponsored).

6.4 It is a condition of entry that competitors may not use their dogs for the advertising of any dog food product when the event is sponsored without prior permission of the Sponsor, in writing.

6.5 It is also a condition of entry that the winner of the Supreme Puppy of the Year Competition may not

be used for the advertising of any dog food product for twelve (12) calendar months after winning the competition, without prior permission of the Sponsor in writing, when the event is sponsored.

7. JUDGING

- 7.1 Each dog will compete against the winners of each Best Puppy in Show held at an All Breeds Championship Show (as detailed in Regulation 5.1 under a Kennel Union licence in the previous calendar year).
- 7.2 A suitably qualified All Breeds Judge approved by the Kennel Union of Southern Africa will judge this event.
- 7.3 All the entrants shall parade around the Show Ring for the judging. Judging is to be done by process of elimination :
- first elimination leaves 16 in the ring
 - second elimination leaves 8 in the ring
 - third elimination leaves 4 in the ring, from which the Judge shall name the Supreme Puppy of the Year and the Reserve Puppy only.

8. PRIZES AND AWARDS

A floating trophy with a miniature will be awarded to the winning dog and a prize shall be awarded to the Reserve Puppy. The owner/handler of the dog which is awarded the title Supreme Puppy of the Year will be given, at the discretion of the Sponsor, a substantial prize in cash or kind.

9. SPONSORSHIP

This event may be sponsored permanently or on an annual basis by any organisation acceptable to both the Federal Council of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa and the Kennel Association. In years when the event is sponsored the title may be preceded by the name of the Sponsor. Should either the Club or Sponsor wish to disassociate themselves with the event, this may not be done so as to prejudice the holding of the event in that year or any succeeding years. For this reason a contract must be drawn up between the Club and any Sponsor establishing the rights and obligations of both, should either or both wish to withdraw from associating with this Competition.
