A. IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

- 1. Complete fully in print.
- Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant and no responsibility for any inconvenience will be accepted.
- 3. Application to be submitted 30 days prior to importation.
- 4. Import permits are valid for a 6-month period and one consignment only.
- 5. Ensure that the following documentation is attached to the application
 - (a) An extended two generation pedigree (if already registered/declared).
 - (b) The performance records (not mandatory for dogs); and
 - (c) Blood typing/DNA certificate (if not available refer to regulation 13(2)(b) and/or DNA certificate/s; and
 - (d) Declaration signed by the relevant Breeders' Society/Registering Authority registered under the Animal Improvement Act, 1998 (Act No. 62 of 1998)
 - (e) For Pets (Canine), all animals must be spayed or neutered and a letter from a Registered Veterinarian must accompany the application.
- 6. The applicant must be a juristic person, e.g. John Peter Citizen, or John Peter Citizen T/A Diepsloot Stud, or Diepsloot Stud CC, of Diepsloot Stud (Pty) Ltd, or Diepsloot Ltd.
- 7. If the applicant does not sign the application personally, a letter authorizing the signatory (agent) to sign the application on behalf of the applicant must accompany the application.
- 8. If an applicant has entered into an agreement with the foreign supplier of the animal's to be imported, in terms of which royalties, fees or concessions, in addition to the purchase price are payable or to be given in respect of the use of such animal/s or progeny thereof, this application shall also be accompanied by a confirmation by the Director-General of the Department of Trade and Industries that such agreement has been approved by this Department.
- 9. Copy of proof of payment of correct fee **(R390.00)** as per approved tariffs must accompany each application (Tariffs changes annually)
