TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Judging and Course Setting is to be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa and Schedule 5C(1), (2) or (3) - Regulations for Retriever Field Trials, Spaniel Field Trials or HPR Field Trials.
2. The Judge undertakes that before judging, he/she will become fully conversant with such Regulations and Guidelines as may be relevant to the stake being judged.
3. The judge is to advise the Hon. Secretary of the Club holding the Trial whether or not this invitation is accepted. If the Hon. Secretary of the Club does not receive the reply within days of the date of offer it will be deemed to have lapsed.
4. Judges domiciled in the KUSA area of jurisdiction must be current members of KUSA at the time of accepting this invitation and at the time of judging.
5. Course setting and approval of tests:
 - a. A Senior Judge agrees to be available to set the course with Supporting Judges and the Field Trial Manager or his/her deputy on a suitable date to be arranged by the Club holding the Trial.
